Hautbois' own private cut onto the River Bure is the perfect location for water sports, including kayaking, canoeing and raft building. Our dry activities include abseiling and climbing, aerial runway, archery, orienteering, pioneering along with many others. Beacon Event

4 - 5 June 2012

Open to Guide and Scout groups, this event celebrates the Queen's Diamond Jubilee with a Beacon at Hautbois. On the evening of the 4th June 2012 beacons will be lit across England and the Commonwealth to mark this special occasion.



The event will start in the afternoon with a series of 60 eco and environmental activities based around our Eco Village, as well as a tree planting ceremony with the Coltishall Tree Warden. After a BBQ supper there will be a campfire before the Beacon is lit.



Groups must attend with their leaders and camp licenses are required. Groups may arrive from 12pm on the Monday. A BBQ is included in the cost, but breakfast is self catering. The event will finish after the Beacon lighting and groups may leave anytime before 12pm on the Tuesday.

The Beacon Event will start at 2.00pm Monday 4th June 2012, though you may arrive from 12.00pm to pitch camp. Dinner is included. The event will finish after the Beacon lighting and you may depart by 12.00pm on Tuesday 5th June 2012. Groups may attend for Beacon Event only and not camp if they wish.
