Where can I book?

When do I arrive and leave?

For camping there are no fixed arrival or departure times (our office is open 9am- 5pm). If you've booked a Reedcutter Cabin then arrival is 3pm and departure 10am.

Can I have a campfire?

Of course! We have altar fires available to use free of charge to keep fires off of the grass and there are pre-bookable campfire circles. Fire wood is available to purchase on-site.

Can I wash up?

We don't have dishwashing facilities but have plenty of drinking water taps to fill containers for washing up.

Can I bring friends & pets?

Sorry no pets! You're more than welcome to camp with friends (you must comply with current government guidance) but please no day guests.

Can I hire camping equipment?

Unfortunately we can't hire equipment currently. However we keep spares in case of an emergency tent disaster!

Is there a shop on site?

Girlguiding Anglia have a small shop onsite selling guiding merchandise. There is a Londis in the village a short walk away which stocks all of the essentials!

Is there a fridge & freezer I can use?

Sorry! Due to current guidelines we cannot offer a communal space. If you have medication that needs to be refrigerated please speak to a member of staff.

Can I bring a gazebo?

With our spacious site, you are welcome to bring gazebos/additional tents and cooking shelters.

Does a warden stay on site?

We don't have anyone staying onsite overnight. We do have an emergency mobile number where staff can be contacted.
